The Approach

What was the scope of their involvement?

Designo Graphy has developed my website and given it various features, including a chat option. They help me with content creation, but they mostly use what I provide. Overall, the team walks me through what they need from me. They've also done the design and colors of the website, but I already have a logo design.
